THIS IS AN EXAMPLE OF THE HARDTKE FONT AFTER IT HAS BEEN PANDOMIZED. NOTE HOW AFTER PANDOMIZATION, THERE ARE DIFFERENT INSTANCES OF THE SAME LETTER DEPENDING ON WHETHER IT IS AT THE BEGINNING OF A WORD, AT THE END, OR IN THE MIDDLE. NOTE, TOO, THAT LETTERS CONNECT MUCH BETTER WHEN FOLLOWING LETTERS WHICH NORMALLY CONNECT TO THE NEXT LETTER ABOVE THE BASELINE, NAMELY "B", "O", "V", AND "W". ALL OF THESE PROBLEMS WERE FIXED BY THE PAHDOMIZER PROGRAM. THE RANDOMIZER PROGRAM MAKES THE PROPER SUBSTITUTIONS AT THE BEGINNING OF WORDS, AND THE END, AND FOR LETTER PAIRS INYOLVING "B", "O", "Y", AND "W". YOUR HANDWRITING FONT MAY ALSO CONTAIN MULTIPLE VERSIONS OF COMMON LETTERS LIKE THE YOWELS, AND IF SO THE PANDOMIZER WILL SUBSTITUTE IN PANDOM VERSIONS OF THOSE LETTERS. ALSO, IF THERE ARE ANY IDIOSYNCRACIES IN YOUR HANDWRITING, THE PAHDOMIZER CAH SUBSTITUTE IN THE CORRECT VERSIONS OF LETTERS TO DEAL WITH IT. FOR INSTANCE, IN THE SAMPLE OF THE HIGHTOWER FONT, NOTE THAT LETTERS WITH DESCENDERS SUCH AS "G", "F", "Y", ETC., ARE USUALLY FOLLOWED BY LETTERS HAVING AH ESPECIALLY LONG LEADING STEM GOING UNDERNEATH THE PRECEDING CHARACTER. BUT NOTE THAT THIS IS NOT THE CASE WITH THE "KELLY" FOUT. THE PAUDOMIZER TOOK CARE OF THIS AUTOMATICALLY.
